

CITATION EXERCISE #3
ENGL 102.1
WRITING AND RESEARCH

The previous citation exercises have shown that you understand the concepts of MLA and APA citation.

This citation exercise is where you put it all together.

For this assignment, you will submit, to your instructor, a properly formatted Works Cited page and a properly formatted References page for 5 of your potential research paper sources. These are to be sources that you have found in your research and may use in your research paper.

There are some formatting and content guidelines for properly completing this assignment.

Format:

What you submit to your instructor for evaluation should have:

- Proper citation formatting to the MLA and APA guidelines
- Two(2) separate pages – one a Works Cited page and one a References page
- Alphabetical order
- Hanging indentation

Content:

The sources that you cite *must* be at least **3** of these 5 types:

- A book, preferably from an academic publisher
- An article from a general interest publication like a magazine or newspaper, but one that you have actually read from the physical periodical (no webreprints or databases).
- An original webpage – a resource only available on the internet.
- A webreprint – a resource that has been printed, but you are using the version presented on a website instead. It can be from the periodicals own website or from another website that gathers articles from multiple periodicals – it doesn't matter.
- A database article – you have to use one of the academic databases and preferably an article from an academic journal as well.

Remember, you will be submitting a Works Cited page AND a References page for the same sources. So you will have 5 sources, but you will submit 10 citations for evaluation.
