This Citation Exercise focuses on the traditional print sources: books, periodicals and anthologies

**A.** For question 10 and 11, you have a source with the following information:

*The title is **The Gospel of Food**. The author is Barry Glassner. The subtitle is **Everything You Think You Know About Food is Wrong**. The publisher is Ecco Books, a division of HarperCollins Publishing. They published the book on January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2007. They are based in New York, NY.*

The publisher of the periodical is NYREV, Inc. The issue is dated January 15, 2009, and is also stated to be Volume LVI, Number 1.*

The anthology was published on October 1, 2004 by the Disinformation Company based in New York.*

*The article is titled “Whose Idea is It Anyway?” The author is Jim Holt. The anthology is titled Quick Studies with a subtitle of The Best of Lingua Franca. The essay begins on page 399 and ends on page 416. It was originally published in the February 1996 issue of Lingua Franca magazine. The editor of the anthology is Alexander Star. The anthology was published by Farrar, Straus and Giroux, based in New York, in 2002.*
