If you read it *from the publisher's website*, not the actual periodical, your citation needs to reflect that

### Reprint Articles from Publisher

Austen, Ben. "End of the Road: After Detroit, The Wreck Of An American Dream." *Harper's Magazine* Aug. 2009: n. pag.

- Since the website does NOT give you page number, you put **n. pag.** instead

### Reprint Articles from Publisher

- Add **the publication medium**

### Reprint Articles from Publisher

Austen, Ben. "End of the Road: After Detroit, The Wreck Of An American Dream." *Harper's Magazine* Aug. 2009: n. pag. **Web. 5 Sep. 2009.**

- Add **the date you accessed the article**

### Reprint Articles from Publisher

Austen, Ben. "End of the Road: After Detroit, The Wreck Of An American Dream." *Harper's Magazine* Aug. 2009: n. pag. **Web. 5 Sep. 2009. <http://...>**

- Add the URL **ONLY** if the reader would have difficulty finding the article on the web

### APA for Reprint Web Article

Austen, B. (2009, August). End of the road: After Detroit, the wreck of an American dream. *Harper's Magazine*, 319. Retrieved September 5, 2009 from <http://www.harpers.org/archive/2009/08/0082595>

- **Must give retrieval date – in this format**

### APA for Reprint Web Article

Austen, B. (2009, August). End of the road: After Detroit, the wreck of an American dream. *Harper's Magazine*, 319. Retrieved September 5, 2009 from <http://www.harpers.org/archive/2009/08/0082595>

- Must give **entire URL** after colon

### APA for Reprint Web Article

Austen, B. (2009, August). End of the road: After Detroit, the wreck of an American dream. **[Electronic version]**. *Harper's Magazine*, 319, 26-36.

- If the web version is **EXACTLY** like the print version, APA offers the option of simply declaring it as an electronic version

### Reprint from 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Website

Marlantes, Liz. "The Deepening Red-Blue Divide." *Christian Science Monitor* 4 Nov. 2004: 1+. Print.

This is the citation for the **PRINT** version

If you get it from a **third-party site** (not the CSM website), you need to reflect that

### Reprint from 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Website

Marlantes, Liz. "The Deepening Red-Blue Divide." *Christian Science Monitor* 4 Nov. 2004: **n. pag.**

Most web sites do **NOT** provide original page numbers – if you don't have the information put **n. pag.** instead

### Reprint from 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Website

- Add the name of **the publication medium**

### Reprint from 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Website

Marlantes, Liz. "The Deepening Red-Blue Divide." *Christian Science Monitor* 4 Nov. 2004: n. pag. Web. **Altnet.**

- Add the **name of the third party site.**

### Reprint from 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Website

Marlantes, Liz. "The Deepening Red-Blue Divide." *Christian Science Monitor* 4 Nov. 2004: n. pag. Web. *Altnet*. 11 Nov. 2004.

- Add the **access date**.

### Reprint from 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Website

Marlantes, Liz. "The Deepening Red-Blue Divide." *Christian Science Monitor* 4 Nov. 2004. *Altnet*. 11 Nov. 2004. <<http://www.altnet.org/election04/200400/>>.

- Add the **URL** of the **SPECIFIC article**, not just the website **if necessary**

### APA Reprint from 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Website

Marlantes, L. (2004, November 4). The deepening red-blue divide. The Christian Science Monitor. Retrieved November 11, 2004 **from the Altnet.org website**: <http://www.altnet.org/election04/200400/>.

- If the article is from a 3<sup>rd</sup> part site, **that site's name MUST** be in the retrieval sentence.
